



## Camp Amigos Summer Camp

### Faculty & Staff

Montessori Children's Academy summer camp will feature the same Montessori certified teachers who are here during the school year.

### Registration & Core Curriculum

Camp Amigos is an 8 week program. Parents must register for a minimum of 2 weeks. Registration begins February 7, 2011. Montessori lessons and Spanish Immersion is provided all day long with two Montessori certified teachers; one who speaks in English and the other in Spanish. The Spanish Immersion Curriculum is a fun way to learn and improve language skills that are essential to your child's future success. Attending in the summer gives students the chance to advance academically rapidly due to a smaller student / teacher ratio.

### Summer Camp Activities

A weekly theme is incorporated to the Montessori curriculum during the summer time. Activities included within the curriculum at Montessori Children's Academy are Yoga, nature discovery, gardening, French, Music, Art, Cooking, Grace, Courtesy & Etiquette classes. Every Friday there is a field trip. On even numbered weeks the field trips are off site and on odd numbered weeks the field trips are on site at MCA. Water Fun Days are every Thursday when children wear their bathing suits and enjoy water fun in the sun. Swimming lessons are also offered for \$25 a week for 2 lessons, by a Red Cross Certified Swimming Instructor on the MCA premises.

### Camp Divisions

Students who attend summer camp are divided into the following divisions: Il Nido Class/Toddler Class which includes students ages 16 months -3 years old who are not potty trained and the Casa dei Bambini/Pre-Primary Class which includes students ages 3-7 years old.

### Meals

Abuelita Carmen makes our organic, tasty and child friendly school lunch which is offered during the summer for \$5 per day. Although most campers choose school lunch, some may want to bring their lunches from home. Those campers are asked to bring their lunches in either a lunchbox or a Ziploc bag with their name on it and an ice box inside if something needs to be refrigerated. The school offers pizza every Thursday for all the students for \$5 per day and is optional. If your child would like pizza on Thursday please be sure to let the office know by Wednesday afternoon so we can plan to purchase the correct amount of pizza for our students.

### Uniforms

All campers are required to wear the gold MCA school T-shirt and navy shorts which are available to purchase at All Uniform Wear. These shirts are also used for school field trips throughout the school year. Sneakers or sandals are recommended. Swimsuits should be worn under your child's uniform and sun block applied on swimming and water days. All students should bring a towel from home on swimming and water fun days.

### Camp Amigos Fees

The registration fee is \$100 for non- MCA students and is \$75 for MCA students. The registration fee holds your child's space in the summer camp and allows us to plan staff according to registration. Tuition fees and information are stated below. In curriculum "Added Extras" (i.e. Yoga, Music etc.) are included in your tuition. Swimming is \$25 for 2 lessons per week. Field trips are charged by week and range in price from \$10 to \$25. For scholarship and sibling tuition discount information please inquire within the office.

### Extended Care

Extended care services will be available before and after camp from 7:30 am to 8:30 am and from 3:30 pm to 6:00 pm for an additional \$20 per week or \$6 per day.
